This document contains templates to print our fun Thanksgiving-themed conversation starters onto paper silverware bags, for use as place settings atyour Thanksgiving dinner.

To print these designs onto the bags:

- 1. Print the BASE page onto regular paper.
- 2. Put your BASE page back into the printer, making sure the edge with the feed arrows gets pulled into the rollers first.
- 3. Print one of the "right side up" question pages onto the BASE page as a test.
 - If your design prints correctly on the bag outline, continue to use the "right side up" question pages.
 - If your design prints upside down, switch to the "upside down" question pages and repeat steps 1-3.
 - If the design isn't centered in the bag outline, draw a new outline.
- 4. Tape two bags to the BASE page where indicated by the outline.
- 5. Print a question page onto the BASE, then carefully remove tape from bags.
- 6. Repeat steps 4-5 for the remaining question pages.
